B Heller also advised that the request for flowers and material for the urns on Main Street were sponsored by individual businesses and that more businesses had requested to sponsor but had not been contacted.

After the bids have been received the board will then determine if they are able to continue with replacement of the flooring in the interior or if it will have to wait until a later date.
