Section One: Purpose

1.0 The purpose of this local law is to amend Local law No 2 of 2010 entitled Licensing and Setting Licensing Fees of Dogs, to increase the license fees and update the impoundment fees.

Section Two: Authority

2.0 This local law is enacted pursuant to the authority vested in the Town Board of Afton by Article 7 of the Agriculture and Market law Section 124, Municipal Home rule law Section 10 and Town Law Section 176.

Section Three: Amendment.

3.0 Section 4.0 License Fees of local law No 2 of 2010 entitled "Licensing and Setting licensing Fees of Dogs"

4.01 the Annual Fee for Each Dog License issued by the Town Clerk and/or Dog Control Officer shall be:

A. For each spayed or neutered dog a \$7.00 License Fee, plus a \$1.00 State Mandated Surcharge Fee.
B. For each un-spayed or un-neutered dog a \$12.00 License Fee, plus a \$3.00 State Mandated Surcharge fee.

C. For each replacement tag a \$5.00 fee.

Section 6.0 Impoundment Fees

A. \$75.00, for the first day, per dog: or the amount of fees charged to the Town of Afton by the Shelter, with a transport fee of \$25.00, whichever is greater.

B. Plus the amount charged by the shelter or pound at which such a dog was harbored following its seizure, including but not limited to costs for food, shelter, and necessary Veterinary Care. To be paid prior to the return of the dog to the owner.

Section Four: Effective Date. 4.0 This local law shall be effective upon its filing with the Secretary of the State of NY.


